TENDER No. T22/2015: PEDESTRIAN IMPROVEMENTS ALONG THE N2 SECTION 8 FROM KM 33.020 TO KM 34.100

Knysna Municipality invites tenders for the pedestrian improvements along the N2 Section from KM 33.020 TO KM 34.100 in Knysna.

Tenderers should have a CIDB contractor grading of **4CE** or higher.

Evaluations will begin with the technical/ functional evaluation. Each responsive technical submission will be given a total score out of 75. A proposal will be considered unsuitable at this stage if it scores less than 60% (45 points) on the technical/functional aspects and will not be further evaluated. All those who satisfy the minimum required score will thereafter be evaluated in terms of price and preference points. The points scored for functionality will not be added to the final points of price and preference. Bidders are required to submit supporting documents on the tabulated criteria

The physical address for collection of tender documents is: **Old main Building, 3 Church Street, Knysna as from Wednesday 22th April 2015.**

Documents may be collected at the compulsory pre-tender meeting from **10h00 on 22 April 2015.**

A non-refundable tender deposit of **R340** payable in cash or by bank guaranteed cheque made out in favour of Knysna Municipality is required on collection of the tender documents.
