Knysna Municipality invites tenders from suitable tenderers for the construction of raft slabs in the Knysna informal areas

A compulsory site briefing meeting will be held on TUESDAY, 17 MAY 2016 at 10h00 at the Council Committee Room, Corporate Building, Clyde Street, Knysna

No person/s will be allowed to join the clarification meeting or to submit a bid if such a person/s are more than fifteen (15) minutes late.

The closing time for submission of bids is **12h00** on **WEDNESDAY, 08 JUNE 2016**. Bids must be sealed in an envelope clearly marked with the bid number and title given above, and placed in the **bid box at the Supply Chain Management Unit, Finance Building, Queen Street, Knysna**, before the latter time and latest date. Telephonic, facsimile, e-mail and late bids will not be accepted. Bids must remain valid for a period of ninety (90) days after the closing date of the bid.

Bids will be opened on the same day at the Supply Chain Management Section at 12h05. Late or unmarked bids will not be considered.

Bids may only be submitted on the bid documentation that is issued.

Interested bidders must tender with local EME/QSE as their sub-contractors. The subcontracting agreement must be attached to your proposal, outlining the proposed relationship and percentage work apportionment

The evaluation of this bid will be subject to functionality evaluation. Tenderers must achieve a minimum functionality score of 45 points out of 75 points. Bids that fail to score the minimum score for functionality will be disqualified. The functionality criteria and weighting is set out in the tender document

Bids will be evaluated according to the **90/10** preference points system. The bids are subject to the Council Supply Chain Management Policy, Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act 2000 and the Preferential Procurement Regulations 2011.

The Municipality reserves the right to withdraw any invitation to bid and/or re-advertise or to reject any bid or to accept a part of it. The Municipality does not bind itself to accept the lowest bid or to award a contract to the Bidder scoring the highest number of points.

It is estimated that Tenderers should have a CIDB contractor designation of **6CE or 6 GB** or higher.

Further requirements for sealing, addressing, delivery, opening and assessment of bids are stated in the Tender Document.
