THE INCUMBENT WILL BE REQUIRED TO PERFORM THE FOLLOWING KEY PERFORMANCE AREAS:

- Operation of DWA Class D water treatment plants
- Take water samples as well as adjusting the chemical dosing accordingly
- Responsible for routine testing of water parameters
- Responsible for backwash filters and scouring of clarifiers
- Responsible to monitor and manage telemetry system
- Responsible for accurate record keeping of all processes
- Responsible for reporting malfunctions (defects) on water pumps, plant equipment and reservoir to the supervisors
- Responsible for on-site Occupational Health and Safety

In addition, the candidates must be:

- Prepared to work shifts, overtime and standby when needed
- Willing to perform hands on tasks to control candidate
