

INFORMAL TRADERS

Info booklet



Requirements to trade:



- Proof of address
- ID
- Details of type of goods or service
- Completed application form
- Receipt of permit fee (Customer Care)
- Eden District Health Certificate if required

You can apply for a permit in a trading area e.g. African Craft Market or for permission to trade as a house shop etc. Containers are only allowed in designated areas. If there is no available space your name will be placed on a waiting list.

If you are interested to trade in a specific trading area please apply as space is limited. All applicants will be screened according to the Informal Traders Policy and Street Trading By-law. Various trading areas have a committee which assists in the management of the area.

Trading areas:

- Templeman Square
- African Craft Market
- Sedgefield Taxi Rank
- Knysna Taxi Rank
- Buffalo Bay etc.



Please note that a trading permit will cost R100 for a three month period and will be renewed if traders comply with code of conduct and following routine inspections.

All informal traders who operate in the greater Knysna area need to be registered as an informal trader and be in possession of a trader permit issued by Knysna Municipality (Economic Development Department). This includes anyone trading on sidewalks, in containers, spaza shops, public open areas etc.
