



ESTUARY WATER QUALITY UPDATE

Water samples were taken from within the Knysna estuary and various Knysna culverts on 5 December 2019. According to the national Department of Water Affairs guidelines, target water quality for recreational use may not exceed 500 E.coli/100ml.

The recent water samples were analysed by an independent laboratory to determine E.Coli levels within the water.
