

## **Knysna's roads to be resurfaced**

Acting Municipal Manager Dawid Adonis confirmed that a three year-long project to see greater Knysna's roads resurfaced and ancillary works done, kicks off this week. "The first phase of the construction period extends from 22 November to 15 December 2021," he said.

The following areas will be improved during this time:

- The beachfront Buffalo Bay parking area;
- Knysna Main Road;
- Nelson Street;
- St George's Street;
- Long Street;
- Rawson Street;
- Hedge Street; and
- Trotter Street.

"Improving our roads is part of our commitment to maintaining and improving the greater Knysna municipal area's infrastructure," Adonis explained. "Maintaining proper road surfaces aids us in providing top-class services to our customers, and will refresh the 'look' of our town."

Works will necessarily affect traffic and road users are asked to observe temporary lane closures, adhere to temporary road signage, and to take extra care while traveling.

"We apologise for the temporary inconvenience these works will cause, and thank you for your patience," Adonis concluded. "This project will not only make for a smoother and safer experience for all road users, but will make it easier to visit, live and do business in Knysna."
