AMENDMENT OF CONTRACTS PROCURED THROUGH THE SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT POLICY OF KNYSNA MUNICIPALITY

PURPOSE

To make public the intention to amend contracts procured through the supply chain management policy of Knysna Municipality.

LEGISLATION

In terms of the Municipal Finance Management Act No 56 of 2003 section 116 (3):

any contract or agreement procured through the supply chain management policy of the municipality may be amended by the parties, but only after -

- (a) the reasons for the proposed amendment have been tabled in council of the municipality; and
- (b) the local community -
 - (i) has been given reasonable notice of the intention to amend the contract or agreement; and
 - (ii) has been invited to submit representations to the municipality".

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS

- (a) T70/2017-18 was awarded to Messrs. Northfield Engineering
 - For supply and delivery of pumps motors and generators including maintenance and repair for various water and sewer pump stations and facilities - to allow for additional expenditure due to vandalism, loadshedding, limited budget and shortage of technical staff. - (b) T71/2017-18 was awarded to Messrs. Megaflo
- To oversee, co-ordinate and supervise maintenance activities on the existing water and wastewater infrastructure and reticulation network of Knysna Municipality - to allow for additional expenditure due to vandalism, loadshedding, limited budget and shortage of technical staff.
