AMENDMENT OF CONTRACTS PROCURED THROUGH THE SUPPLY CHAIN MANAGEMENT POLICY OF KNYSNA MUNICIPALITY

PURPOSE

To make public the intention to amend contracts procured through the supply chain management policy of Knysna Municipality.

LEGISLATION

In terms of the Municipal Finance Management Act No 56 of 2003 section 116 (3):

"A contract or agreement procured through the supply chain management policy of the municipality may be amended by the parties, but only after -

- (a) the reasons for the proposed amendment have been tabled in council of the municipality; and the local community -
- (i) has been given reasonable notice of the intention to amend the contract or agreement; and
- (ii) has been invited to submit representations to the municipality".

PROPOSED AMENDMENTS

- (a) Expansion of tender: T32 of 2017/18: Resurfacing and ancillary works on roads in the Greater Knysna area - expansion of the contract for an additional R4,451,333 excluding VAT, to allow time for the department to finalize work for the current financial year and to re-advertise the tender. The current tender was advertised on 80/20 preference point system, but all tenders came in above the threshold. Further details may be obtained from S Maree on smaree@knysna.gov.za;
- (b) Expansion of tender: T04/2019/20: Construction of 132 top structures, Qolweni, Knysna - to make provision for an expansion of R1,391,972 excluding VAT, to allow for COVID-19 and Health & Safety related claims. Further details may be obtained from L Petuna on lpetuna@knysna.gov.za;
- (c) Expansion of tender: T15 of 2018/19: Construction of the civil works, Phase 2A Upgrading of the Sports Field on erf 214, White Location, Knysna - to allow for additional emergency work performed due to heavy rains to the value of R394,212 VAT included. - (d) Expansion of tender: T31 of 2018/19: Construction of a Multi-purpose centre, White Location, Knysna - to allow for additional expenditure due to standing time as a result of community interference and unrest on site, COVID-19 claims and delays due to inclement weather. The expansion will be to the amount of R250,000 VAT included. Further details may be obtained from S Langlands on slanglands@knysna.gov.za;
